If you are charged with a disqualifying offence as prescribed by the *Care and Protection of Children (Screening) Regulations*, you are required under the Act to notify SAFE NT and your employer in writing as soon as practicable. The penalty for not notifying of this change in circumstance is \$9,250 (as of July 2024) or imprisonment for 6 months. Your application for a Working With Children Clearance Notice has been finalised, and I am pleased to enclose your Clearance Notice Certificate.

However, SAFE NT is unable to issue you with a physical Ochre Card as you have not provided an **acceptable** photo with your application.

An Ochre Card will be produced free of charge when you provide a new photo that meets the following standards:

Photos should meet the following standards:

- Photos must not be more than six months old.
- It must be 45-50 mm in height and 35-40 mm in width (passport sized)
- It must show a close up of the applicant's head and the top of the shoulders
- The image must be centred, clear and in sharp focus with no shadows;
- The image must be in colour, of high quality, with no ink marks or creases;
- If taken with a digital camera, the photograph must be of a high quality and resolution (no pixelated images) and printed on photo-quality paper

Should you choose to email a photo to us, it must be in either jpeg or pdf format to the following email address: safent.police@nt.gov.au or post a photo to us at PO Box 39764, Winnellie NT 0821. A photocopy of your photo identification (ie driver's licence, passport or Proof of Age card) is to be included with your photo. Please ensure that any correspondence you send clearly states your full name and date of birth, along with a return postal address.

Applicants in the Darwin Region can attend SAFENT at 71 Smith Street for an image to be taken at no cost.
